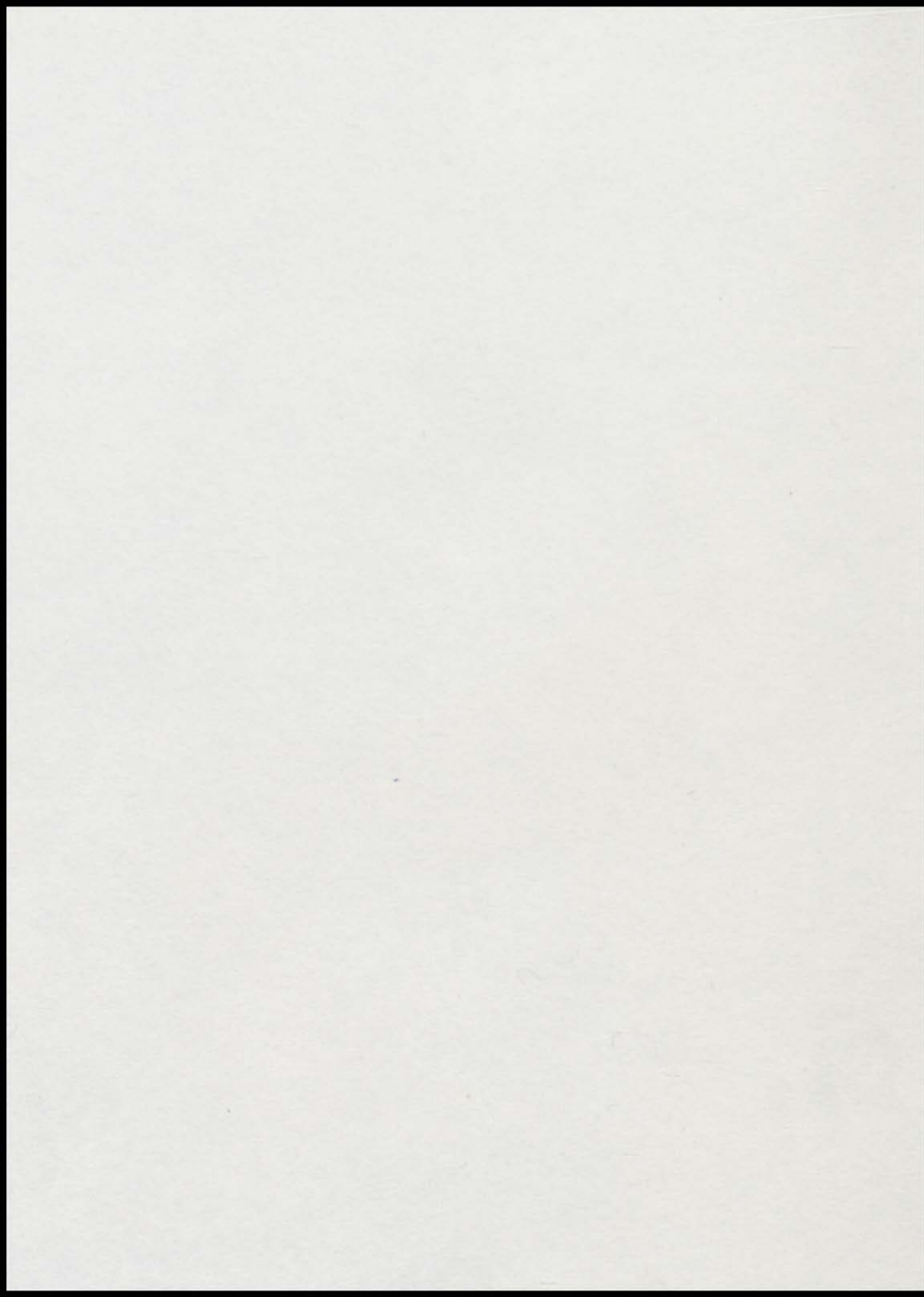

# DEDICATION



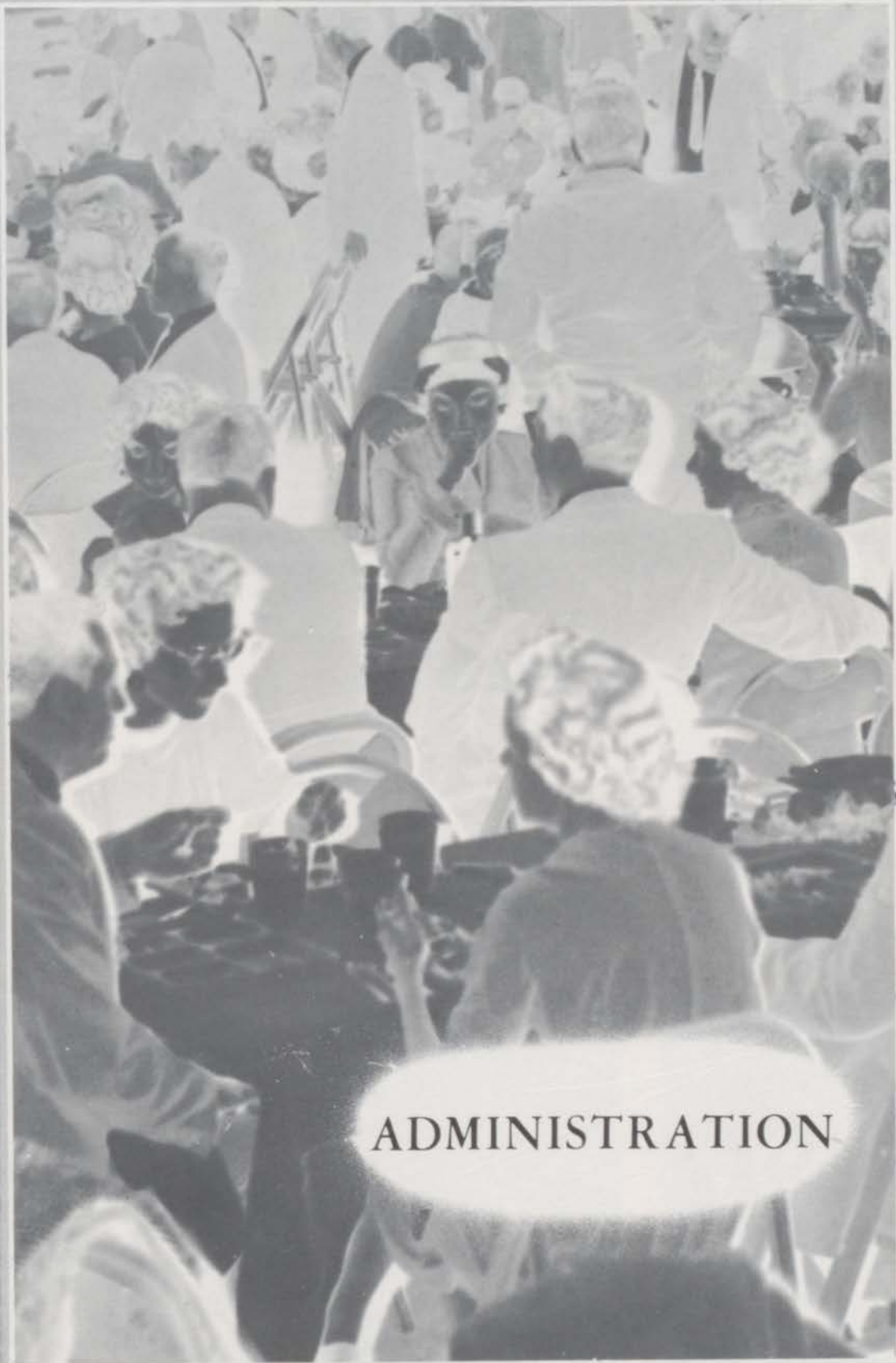
We, the Senior Class of 1961-62 wish to dedicate our annual to Stanley Melville Robbins.
