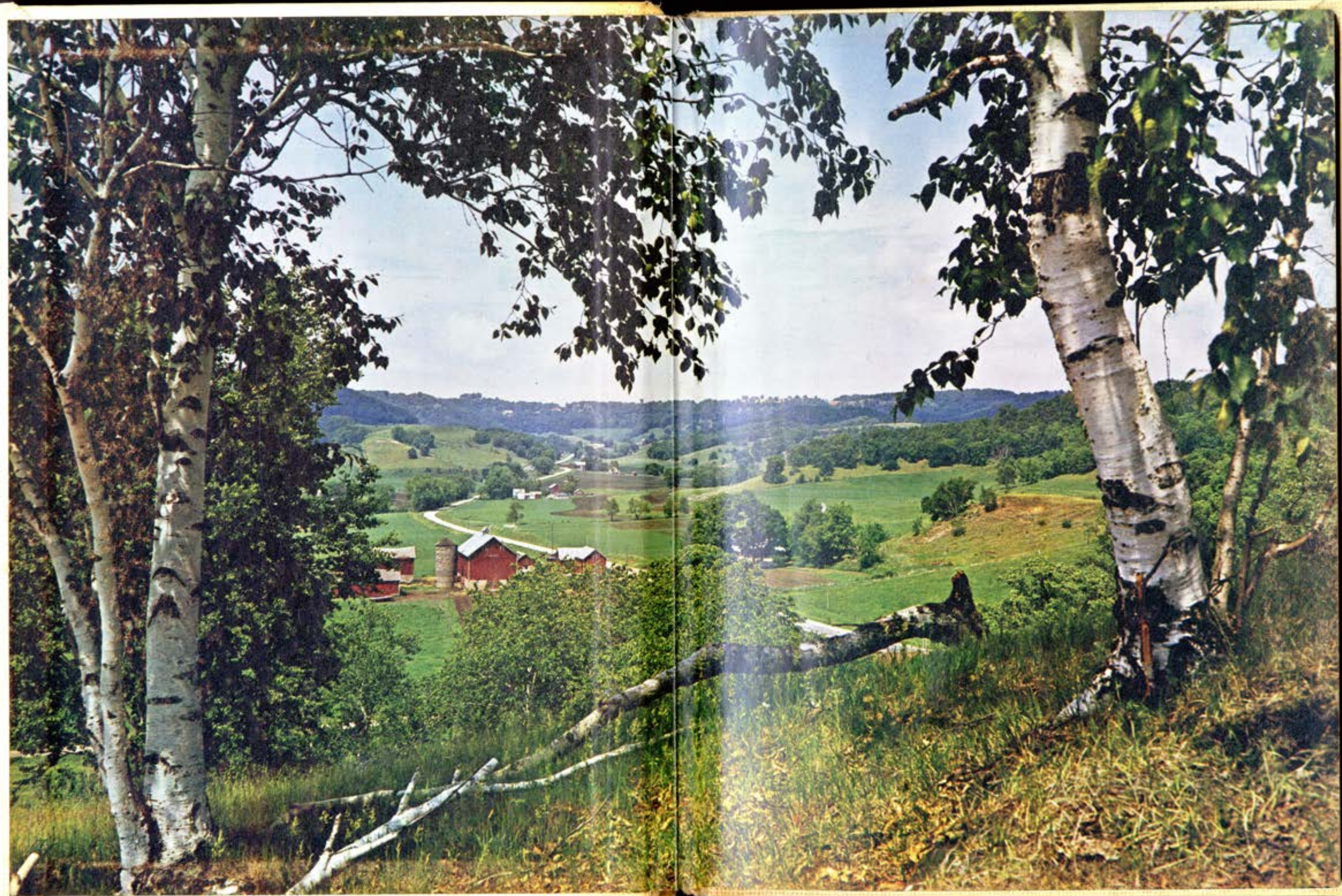

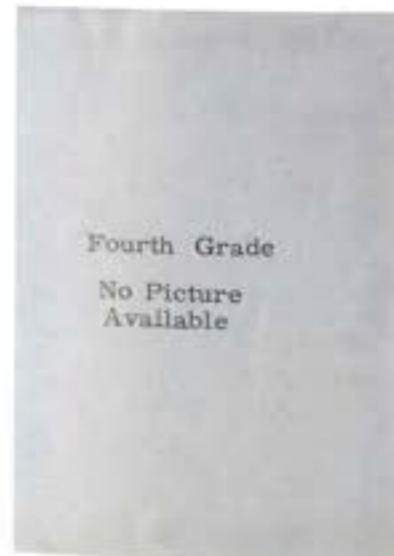

 Ever since she went and got caught by the "Law."

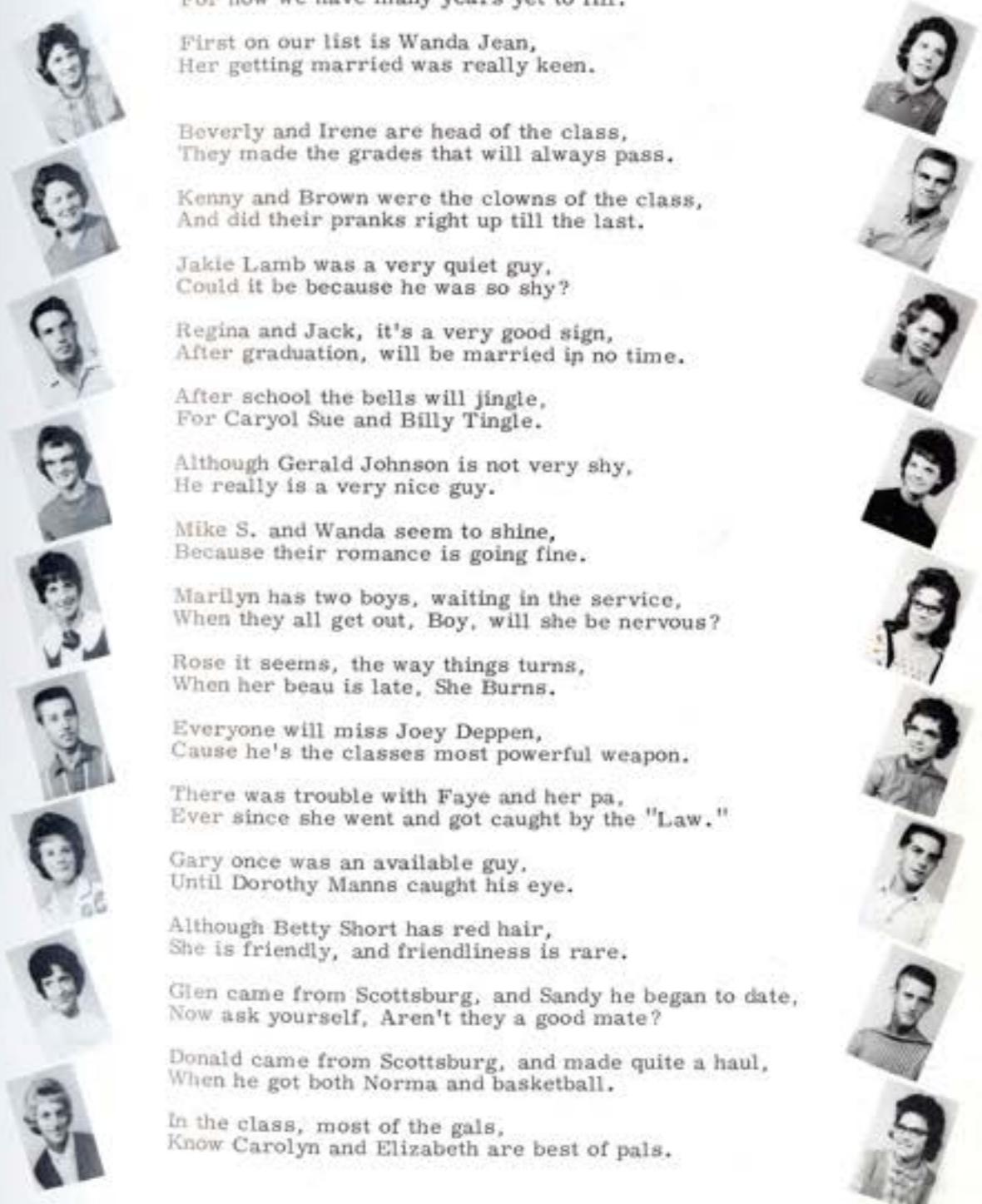
Gary once was an available guy,

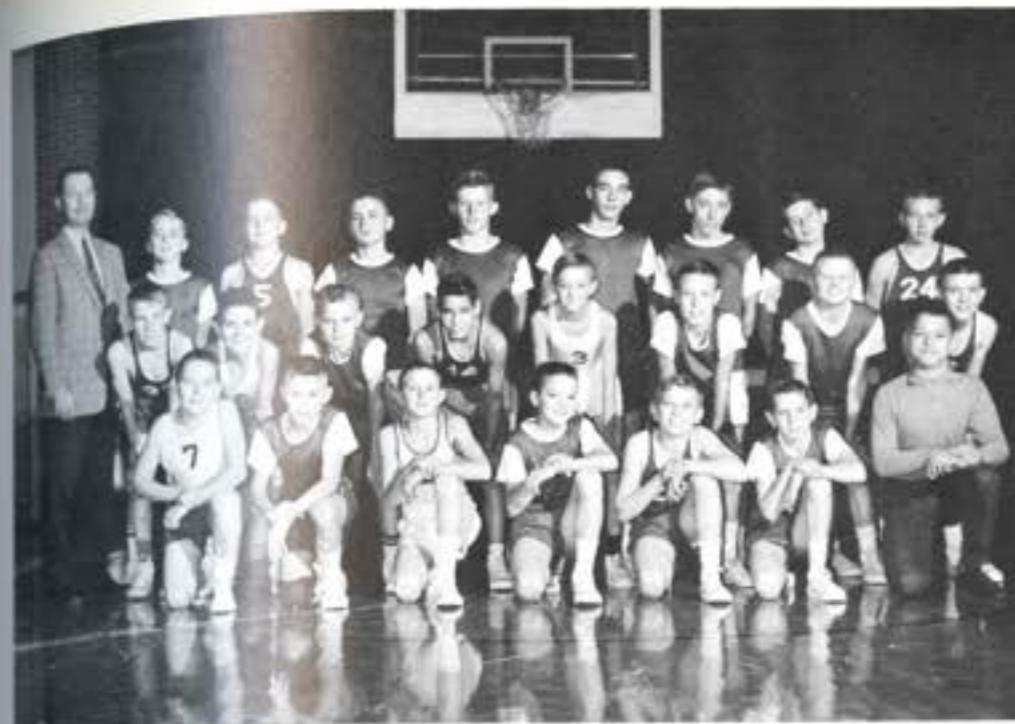
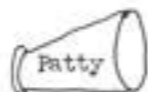
